

Resolution creating Ad Hoc committee to study the state of excellence in our district

Excellence is the goal of our district, and it is the promise the Board makes to our students, parents, and community. To that end, the Board will appoint an ad hoc committee to define excellence within our district, find examples of excellence already existing (with an eye to replication), and find those areas where excellence has yet to be achieved.

The committee would be appointed to the board from members of the public who make application. One volunteer educator from each level (elementary, middle school, high school) would be chosen for the committee. No more than 12 or fewer than 10 members of the public would be included. At least 25 percent of the members would be parents (not district employees or married to district employees). The committee would choose a chair from its own members, would operate independently, would be able to request information from district administrators. The committee would report back to the board one year after establishment in a public meeting.
